

JUNEAU-DOUGLAS PLATTING BOARD
July 11, 1961

A special meeting of the Juneau-Douglas Platting Board was held in the office of Olsen & Sands, 109 W. Third, Juneau, at 8:00 P.M., July 11, 1961.

Members present were: Charles H. Jones, Bjarne Olsen, C. T. Brown, Jack Shepard and James DeHart.

The Minutes of the previous meeting of June 20, 1961, were read and approved.

Mr. Carlos T. Brown submitted his resignation from the Juneau-Douglas Platting Board, effective July 15, as he has moved from Douglas. It was moved, seconded, and unanimously approved that the Board recommend to Mayor Boehl that Mr. Brown's resignation be accepted, and that Mayor Boehl appoint someone to fill his place. The Clerk was instructed to write a letter of thanks to Mr. Brown for his services.

The motion was made, seconded and unanimously approved that a letter be written by the Clerk to the City of Juneau, requesting them to appoint a member to the Juneau-Douglas Platting Board to fill an existing vacancy.

By Resolution, the following subdivisions were approved:

- No. 78 Subdivision of a fraction of USS 1942, located near the end of the Fritz Cove Road and owned by Mr. and Mrs. Glen H. Mielke.
- No. 79 Subdivision of Forest Park, Fraction of USS No. 1155 on Fritz Cove Road, approved subject to proof of payment of taxes.

Mr. Bruce Campbell submitted a plat of Subdivision of Lot H, Tract A, of USS No. 2388. After discussion, the Clerk was requested to write a letter to Mr. Campbell, asking him to submit a letter of enclosure explaining the survey, and that such a letter accompany all submittals.

There being no further business, the meeting thereupon adjourned.
